PLEASE READ

The Broward County Parks Department and Broward County Radio Control Association jointly welcome you to the Markham Park flying site. Flying at Markham Park is granted by the Broward County Board of Commissioners subject to Compliance with the official AMA safety code and the following Broward County Parks safety rules, regulations and Posted signs which have been adopted by the Broward County Radio Control Association.

1. Before flying at this field all pilots must produce adequate proof of Comprehensive General Usability Insurance coverage. Display of a current membership card with the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) is acceptable.
2. The official AMA Safety Code and guidelines are in effect at this flying site.
3. All transmitters will be impounded unless the pilot has control of their frequency. All flight frequencies are obtained by the pilot placing their AMA Membership Card in the proper slot designed for frequency control. All transmitters must display the pilots name and frequency number. Additionally, transmitters must display a frequency channel flag as per AMA guidelines. Pilots must rotate the frequency after 15 minutes of use.
4. A maximum of five aircraft are allowed to be airborne at any one time. The aircraft must be flown within the area north of the runway, west of the eastern park boundary and southeast of the park road. A maximum of two helicopters are allowed in the air at any one time and must be flown in the designated helicopter area: 50 feet west of the pit area, south of the flight line and 100 feet from any traffic way.
5. Pilots must fly from the flight line pads except during take-offs and landings. No one should be forward of the flight line unless they have take-off or landing clearance. Unless special clearance is given only one pilot may take-off or land at one time. Landing aircraft have runway right-of-way. Dead stick landings have first priority. Pilots must announce their intentions to establish clearance.
6. Engines are not to be started or run except in the pit or flying area. Spectators are not permitted in the pit or flying areas.
7. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in the pit or flying areas. No one under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be allowed in the pit or flying areas.
8. All posted regulations must be observed.
9. Common sense will apply at all times. Safety, being paramount, is everyone's responsibility.
10. The above rules are additions to the Markham Park General Rules of the park. All rules of the flying field and Markham Park are to be observed while at this field. Any violations of these safety regulations can subject the offender to removal from this flying site.
11. A Markham Park Approved flyers Card must be displayed on your person to be in the pit area or on the flight line. They can be obtained at the Park Office.
